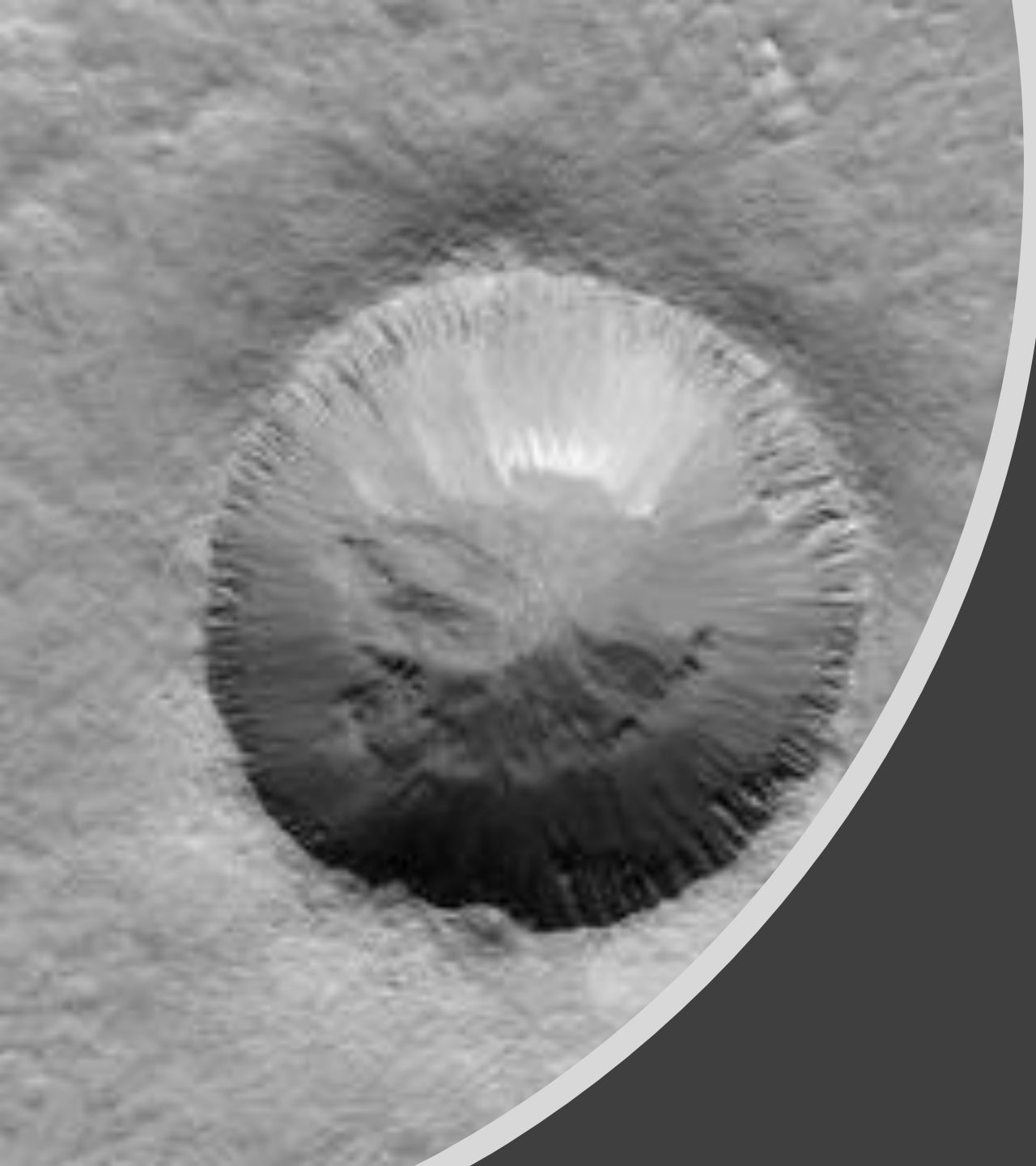

We are always asking the question, “How does what I am currently doing – or planning to pursue in relation to all things, positively count/contribute to my life having IMPACT for Christ and His Kingdom”? And if the answer is, “It doesn’t”, then I no longer do/pursue that thing, or it is severely diminished to the point that it becomes a very insignificant part of my life.
